



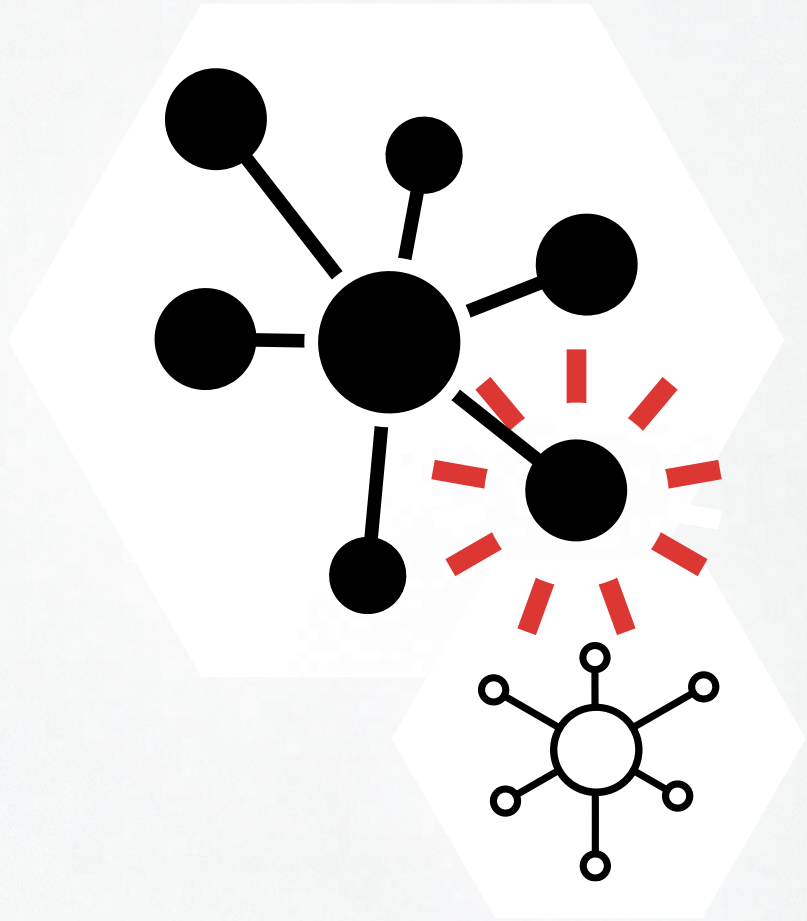

A brief synopsis of project ...elevator speech

Intellectual Merit

- NSF: The potential for the proposed project to advance knowledge and understanding within its own field or across different fields.
 - **Review Criteria** (does the proposed project... and to what extent does the proposed project)
 - Advance knowledge and understanding within its own field or across different fields
 - Develop or Explore creative, original, or potentially transformative concepts?
 - Present a plan that is well-reasoned, well-organized, and based on a sound rationale
 - Is there an effective plan to assess success?
 - Is the individual, team, or organization qualified to implementing the project?
 - Are there adequate resources available to the PI to carry out the proposed activities?

Broader Impacts

- NSF: The potential for the proposed project to benefit society and contribute to the achievement of specific, desired societal outcomes
 - **Review Criteria:** (same items as listed for Intellectual Merit using the above lens)
 - What examples of Broader Impacts are presented by the NSF

 - STEM Education/Workforce Development
 - Economic Competitiveness or Social Well-Being
 - Enhancing STEM Research Infrastructure or National Security
